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Subject Note clarifying reorientation of batch building within the scope of

Section 73 application

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Introduction

This note has been prepared following a meeting with officers from Blaenau Gwent County Borough Council (BGCBC) on 5th December 2023. Further clarification was sought from officers as to whether the changes proposed to the batch building, predominantly relating to its reorientation, fall within the scope of the current Section 73 (s73) application (ref: 07/2023/0209) and that a proportionate assessment of the implications of this on noise has been undertaken.

Proposed Changes to Batch Building

The proposed changes to the batch building which fall within the scope of the current s73 application comprise the following:

• Rotating the proposed batch building by 90 degrees, with the longer elevations now facing east and west. This change was essential in reducing the overall size of the service yard, reducing the overall footprint of the development, and subsequently allowing the relocation of the

layout.

- Omission of 12no. bulk material storage silos, 6 on each side of the building. There will be a reduction in on-site bulk storage, resulting in a reduction to the overall building footprint.
- Introduction of two material feeder units for sand delivery. The solution resulted in very deep basement structures. The shallower basements result in a more efficient design solution.
- Relocation of the conveyor bridge structure from the end of the building to the side. This was
 required due to the rotation of the building as noted above.
